Heat Wave in Hyderabad: This summer Hyderabad is experiencing a severe heat wave with temperatures as high as 118 degrees Fahrenheit. It's too hot for most people to come onto the streets and people are urged to avoid going outside between the hours of 11am and 4pm. People have prayed for rain and a recent shower brought some relief to millions in Hyderabad. The monsoon will start soon and relieve the water scarcity problem.

New School Year !!! The staff and students at the Good Shepherd School finished their summer break and returned on June 12th for the 2015-2016 school year. The results of the 10th grade (high school) students' final exams conducted by the State have been announced. Praise God - the two students, Pavan Sai and Srikanth who took the exams successfully made distinguished honor roll and graduated from The Good Shepherd School. Pray for their future career goals. Also, pray for Phase II and Phase III of the school building project that needs to be completed.





<u>Computer Center and Sewing Centers</u>: Please pray for the Computer Center situation. Recently, the group that supported it financially discontinued the funding due to their budget cuts. The Computer Center is temporarily relocated on a church premise and will resume once we gain enough support to operate the Center. Many women have benefitted from the Computer Center both by way of learning computer skills as well as hearing the Gospel. The twenty Sewing Centers have currently 125 students enrolled for tailoring training.

2015 Mission Trip: A group of 16 people will be traveling to India this summer (July 8th-24th) as part of the 8th annual Sunshine Ministries Mission Trip. All have obtained Indian Visas except for four who are still waiting to hear from the Indian Embassy. Twelve suitcases of school and ministry supplies have been packed and ready to be taken to India by the team members. Praise God for all those who donated these items. During this trip, we plan to conduct a three day Pastors' conference. The sixty pastors associated with Sunshine Ministries will be trained and encouraged during these sessions. Activities planned at the Good Shepherd School and Children's Home include moral stories with arts & crafts, sports, songs, Bible clubs and spoken-English classes. The team will also get the opportunity to visit the sewing centers to encourage the women in their efforts of learning the skills. On Sundays, the Mission Team will visit local churches for morning worship services and children's rallies, as well as the youth and women's meetings later in the afternoon. Please pray that our presence and our teaching be a great encouragement to all of them.

We are excited for the Mission Trip and ask for your support through prayer, specifically for wisdom for our ministerial opportunities, provision, safety, good health, and God's direction for us. Pray that God will help all of us to complete our preparations. We also invite you to partner with Sunshine Ministries through prayer and financial support. We trust God will provide all we need to do the work that He has called us to do. Please keep our team in your prayers, so that we may use our talents and gifts for His glory alone.
